Recuerden que hay **verbos regulares**, para formar el pasado solo tengo que agregarle **ED** al verbo:

Infinitive	Past Simple (regular verbs)
Walk	Walked
Play	Played
watch	Watched
listen	Listened
jump	Jumped

Y hay **verbos irregulares**, no se les agrega ED. No hay una regla para formar los verbos irregulares. ¡Hay que aprenderlos! ¡Algunos de ellos están en esta lista!

IRREGULAR PAST TENSE VERBS

There is no rule for the formation of irregular verbs. **You have to memorize them!**

The Simple Past (afirmativo)

I
He
She
It + verbo en el pasado (regular + ed o irregular 2da columna de verbos)
They
We
you

Ejemplos: I **had** coffee for breakfast. My friends **invited** me to a party. My sister **went** to the cinema yesterday.

Negativo (cómo decir que NO hice algo)

I
He
She
It + **didn't** + verbo en infinitivo (el verbo no cambia)
They
We
You

Ejemplos: "I **didn't have** coffee for breakfast". "My friends **didn't invite** me to a party". "My sister **didn't go** to the cinema yesterday".

Who | SHE
What + **DID** + IT + verbo en infinitivo (el verbo no cambia) ?
Why | THEY

What did you do yesterday? Where did she go? Did Pedro study at the weekend?
