Negative Sentences

Common mistakes:

- It ~~weren~~ fun. **Cc (Concord) + SP (Spelling mistake)**
It wasn't fun.
- George didn't ~~played~~ music in Paris. **WW (Wrong Word)**
George didn't play music in Paris.
- She ~~diden't~~ stop there. **SP + Apostrophe (!)**
She didn't stop there.
- My aunt ~~doesn't was~~ at home last night. **VT (Verb Tense) + WW**
My aunt wasn't at home last night.
