PART 1

Part 1 of the PET Speaking exam lasts about **2-3 minutes**. During Part 1 the examiner will ask you some easy questions to find out more about you such as about your studies, where you live or what hobbies or interests you have. You do not have to give long answers to these questions. However, you should try to say more than short one or two word answers.

You will need to use **present and past tenses** when you answer the questions. Some of these words might be useful:

village, town, city, in the countryside, house, apartment study, learn, full-time, part-time, self-study, evening classes, private lessons, hobbies, relax, go shopping, play tennis/football ...

Possible questions:

3	What nationality are you?
4	Where do you live?
5	Are you a student? Do you work or are you a student in ...? What do you do/ study?
6	Have you got a boyfriend / girlfriend?
7	Can you spell your family name?
8	Do you enjoy studying English? Why? Why not?
9	Do you think that English will be useful for you in the future?
10	Have you got any brothers or sisters?
11	Have you got any children?
12	How do you get to school?
13	How long does it take to come to school?
14	Tell me about your day at school/college
15	Tell me about your family
16	What is your favourite food?
17	What are your hobbies?
18	What are your plans after school?
19	What did you do yesterday / last weekend?
20	What do you do in your spare time?
21	What do you study? What are your favourite subjects?
22	What's your job? What do you do?
