A forma verbal em inglês **there to be** expressa sentido de **haver, existir ou ter**, em português. Em inglês, o verbo varia de acordo com o número, de singular para plural, e de acordo com a variação temporal de presente para passado e futuro.

- Logo, **na afirmativa** temos duas formas, o **there is** e o **there are**.
- Para a forma **negativa**, apenas acrescentamos a palavra **NOT**.
There is - **There is not** There are - **There are not**
- Para a forma **interrogativa**, apenas trocamos o **verbo to be** com o **there**, observe:
There is- **Is there?** There are – **Are there?**
- **Formas abreviadas:**
There is: **there's** There is not: **There isn't** There are not: **There aren't**
