









# Weathering and Erosion Worksheet

Sort the pictures under **weathering** and **erosion**.

<h2>Weathering</h2> <p>the <u>breaking down</u> of rocks</p>		<h2>Erosion</h2> <p>products of weathering are moved from one place to another</p>	

 <p>The roots of the tree caused the rock to crack.</p>	 <p>The mud is moving the rocks down.</p>	 <p>The rain washed away the dirt.</p>	 <p>Water got into the crack of a rock and when the water froze, the rock cracked.</p>
 <p>The wind is carrying the sand away.</p>	 <p>The canyon is smooth because of the ocean water.</p>	 <p>The hurricane caused the rocks to break into tiny pieces.</p>	 <p>The river is carrying the products downhill.</p>

**Hint:** if it is **breaking**, it is *weathering*! If it is **moving** it is *erosion*!
