








Read to understand this illustration carefully.

Upin and Ipin **share** 6 chicken wings **equally**.





Opah helps to **share** the chicken wings **equally**.



She **shares** by giving each boy one chicken wing at a time.



Opah gives one each and still remains 4



Opah gives one more each and still remains 2



All shared equally.
No more left

Each boy gets **equal number** (**same number**) of chicken wings.

Upin gets **3 chicken wings** and Ipin gets **3 chicken wings** too.

6 chicken wings are **shared equally**.
