

# VERB + OBJECT + VERB

If you use one of these verbs you <b>don't</b> have to <b>use "to"</b> after the object: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• LET</li><li>• MAKE</li><li>• HAVE</li><li>• HELP</li></ul>	If you use one of these verbs you have to <b>use "to"</b> after the object: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ASK</li><li>• INVITE</li><li>• TELL</li><li>• REMIND</li></ul>
Example: She'll <b>help</b> you <b>send</b> the email.	Example: My father <b>asked</b> me <b>to help</b> my brother.
