When do we use...**WAS** or **WERE**? (x7)

We use **WAS** for something singular;

we use **WERE** for a plural.

Singular means one;

plural means more than one.

I , we , she , you , he ,
they , the king , the mice , they ,
my dog , the cats , my sister , your friends
, the house , his shoes , the queen .

We use **WERE** with **YOU**, because **YOU** can be plural or singular (X2).

You very cheeky, you naughty dogs. You amazing
my little cat. You all in trouble, boys and girls. You
very beautiful your majesty.

The footballers , the window , her brothers ,
the carrot , you , my bag , the King and
queen , the mouse , my pencil , the chairs
, your drink , the clocks , an ant ,
