1. you shopping every day? (go)
..... you shopping tomorrow?

2. you tennis this Sunday? (play)
..... you tennis on Sundays?

3. Mary usually cereals for breakfast? (have)
..... Mary cereals for breakfast today?

4. What kind of films you usually? (watch)
What kind of film you tonight?

5. How often you your grandparents? (visit)
Usually once a week, but this week I them twice because it's my grandfather's birthday.

Past Simple or Past Continuous?

1. When Peter at home, I dinner.
2. While I a shower, the phone
3. While the children in the garden, it raining.
4. While we the film, I asleep on the sofa.
5. I when the baby to cry.

Past Simple or Present Perfect?

1. - I (never / be) to London!
- Really? I (go) to London last year!

2. Oh no! I can't open the door. I (lose) my keys.
- That's terrible! I (lose) my keys last week and I was desperate.

3. - you (already / do) your homework?
- No. I (decide) to do my homework later because I'm really tired.

4. - I (see) Peter for a long time. How is he?
- Oh, I (see) him yesterday at work. He's pretty good!

- Actually I (have) dinner with him last night.
