# Anne Frank

Annelie Marie Frank was born on June 12, 1929. She was born in Frankfurt, **Germany**. Her family moved to Holland because the **Nazis wanted to eliminate all the Jews**. Nazis put Jews into concentration camps of torture and they killed lots of Jews too.

On July 6, 1942, Anne and her family **hid from the Nazis in a secret attic** in her father's office. They stayed in the attic for 25 months. The **Nazis discovered Anna and her family** and they were sent to the Westerbork concentration camp. Some members of the family were separated and sent to Auschwitz in 1944. Later, Anna and her sister Margot were moved to the concentration camp Bergen-Belsen. **Anne died there in March 1945.**

Later, after her death, a woman named Miep Giles discovered a diary in the attic where Anna Frank lived. It was **Anne's diary!** In 1947, the diary was published and translated in 67 languages. The diary became very famous in lots of countries around the world. Anne Frank was an amazing and very brave woman!
