A yurt is the 1) home of nomadic **TRADITION** people from Mongolia, Siberia, China and Central Asia. The word 'yurt' or 'yurta' 2) comes from the Turkish **ORIGIN** word meaning 'dwelling place.' It is 3) in shape and is easy to **CIRCLE** assemble, take down and transport. Made of a 4) frame and covered **WOOD** with felt, it is a popular place to live in the summer months. You will sometimes find it used in other countries too, as it is an 5) form of temporary **EXPENSIVE** housing. In Europe, 6) on **VARY** Mongolian and Central Asian-styled yurts are made using other materials, such as local hardwoods. Yurts are used for all sorts of different purposes, from permanent housing to school rooms.
