There are about 3000 lakes in Scotland called **lochs** and there are almost 800 islands. There are more than 5 million inhabitants. The capital is Edinburgh but Glasgow is the largest city.

Scotland's national animal is a unicorn, although it is a mythical creature and the thistle is the symbol of Scotland.



Flag

The national flag of Scotland is blue with a white cross. The flag is known as St Andrew's cross.

Well-known Scottish writers are: Walter Scott, Arthur Conan Doyle, the author of the Sherlock Holmes novels. Scotland's most famous poet is Robert Burns. His birthday is celebrated all over the world by Scotsmen wherever they are on 25 January. It is Burn's night. Some famous actors from Scotland are Sean Connery, Ewan McGregor, Gerard Butler, Billy Connolly, James McAvoy, Rose Leslie.

Patron Saint

St Andrew is the patron saint of Scotland. St Andrew, who was St Peter's brother, was a fisherman and Christ's first apostle. He was crucified on an X-shaped cross.
