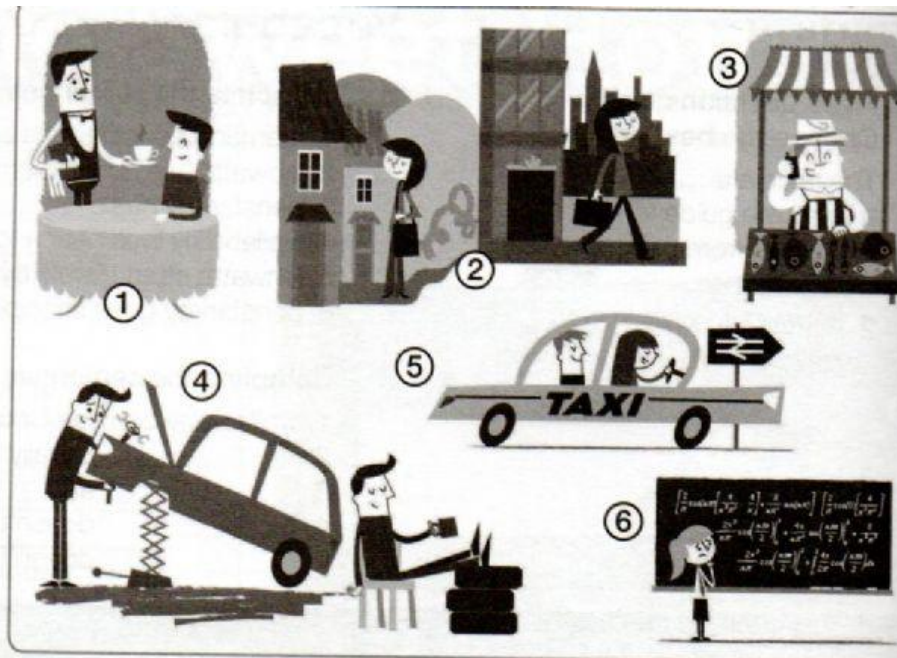


Grammar Present simple and continuous
