

NEIL ARMSTRONG

Neil Alden Armstrong was born on 5 August 1930 in Wapakoneta, Ohio, U.S.A. When Neil was a child, he loved to learn all about aeroplanes and space. When Neil was 17, he went to Purdue University to study aeronautical engineering. He became an astronaut. Armstrong's first trip to space was in 1966. On 20th July 1969 Neil Armstrong landed the moon during the NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) Apollo 11 mission. He did it with Collins and Aldrin. The footprints made by Armstrong and Aldrin are still on the Moon. Armstrong retired from NASA in 1971 and started teaching engineering at the University of Cincinnati. He died on 25 August 2012.
