




## Let's Learn!

### Multiplying 5: Skip-counting

1 One finger stands for 5.


$$1 \times 5 = 5$$



Skip count in 5s with your fingers!



What do ten fingers stand for?



$$10 \times 5 = 50$$

Ten fingers stand for 50.

2 Nina has 7 bunches of flowers.  
Each bunch has 5 flowers.  
How many flowers does she have altogether?

$$7 \times 5 = ?$$

7 groups of  
5 flowers



I count in 5s.  
5, 10, 15, 20,  
25, 30, 35

Nina has 35 flowers altogether.

3 Ali has 6 starfish in his tank.  
Each starfish has 5 arms.  
How many arms do the 6 starfish have altogether?

6 groups of  
5 arms



I count in 5s.  
5, 10, [red box], [red box],  
[red box], [red box]


$$\boxed{\phantom{0}} \times \boxed{\phantom{0}} = \boxed{\phantom{0}}$$

The 6 starfish have [red box] arms altogether.
