

HOW MUCH DO YOU KNOW ABOUT CROCODILES?

Crocodiles are big animals. They eat fish, birds, other animals and sometimes they eat people too! They don't eat grass or plants. Look inside a crocodile's mouth and you will find a lot of teeth! They can have between 60 and 80 teeth! A crocodile has got a long body, a long tail and short legs. But be careful because they can swim and they can run too!

When crocodiles swim, they can see. Their mouths are under the water but their eyes are above the water. A crocodile's eyes are on the top of its head. You can find crocodiles in many parts of the world. Some of them only live in rivers, but some crocodiles can live in the sea too.

A mother crocodile sits on her egg for about 12 weeks. Then, the eggs open and the mother carries her baby crocodiles into the river.

Crocodiles are dangerous animals. You should never go near them!
