Jean Michel Basquiat, a trail blazer.

Basquiat (bear PV) on December 22, 1960, in Brooklyn, New York. His

mother, an American of Puerto Rican descent, (encourage, PT) his

interest in art. After his parents (separate, PT), Basquiat

(live, PT) with his father in Puerto Rico from 1974 to 1976. His mother

(diagnose, PV) as mentally ill and eventually

(institutionalize, PV). He (Trouble, PV) by his early

childhood, Basquiat (drop, PT) out of high school and

(leave, PT) home at age 17. He (live) on the streets, with friends, or in abandoned buildings.

Basquiat (begin) a graffiti campaign with graffiti artists Al Diaz and

Shannon Dawson. They (create, PT) the persona SAMO©

and (paint, PT) anonymous messages on walls and on subway trains in New York City. In the late 1970s that work—together with the work of other graffiti artists_ (begin, PT) to receive notice in the art world, and so did Basquiat.

Basquiat (take, PT) part in his first formal public exhibition in "The Times Square Show" (1980). From there his career skyrocketed. Basquiat (become, PT) a celebrity and (represent, PV) by major art galleries in New York and Germany.

Although he (lack, PC) any formal training, Basquiat (create, PT) highly expressionistic work that mixed graffiti and signs with the gestural and intuitive approach of Abstract Expressionist painting. He (make, PT) many highly stylized self-portraits that addressed his personal anxieties. His paintings also (allude, PT) to African American historical figures, including jazz musicians, sports personalities, and writers. Basquiat freely mixed themes from African, Caribbean, Aztec, and Hispanic cultures. He also mixed "high art" references with images from popular culture, especially cartoons to denounce police brutality, social and racial inequality. He (die, PT) at 27.
