

# Laughter

<b>TO LAUGH</b>		To laugh repeatedly in a quiet but uncontrolled way, often at something silly or rude or when you are nervous
<b>INAPPROPRIATE</b>		To take action, to do something, to behave
<b>TO GIGGLE</b>		To make the spontaneous sounds and movements of the face and body that are the instinctive expressions of amusement and sometimes also of derision.
<b>CARTOON</b>		not useful or suitable for a particular situation.
<b>TO ASSUME</b>		The action of balancing yourself upside down on your hands with your body and legs straight up in the air.
<b>FUNNY</b>		a simple drawing showing the features of its subjects in a humorously exaggerated way, especially a satirical one in a newspaper or magazine.
<b>HILARIOUS</b>		a lateral handspring with arms and legs extended
<b>BRAIN</b>		a ceremony or service held shortly after a person's death
<b>HANDSTAND</b>		extremely amusing
<b>CARTWHEEL</b>		The organ inside your head that controls your body's activities and enables you to think and to feel things such as heat and pain.
<b>SMART</b>		the way in which one acts or conducts oneself
<b>FUNERAL</b>		foolish, childish, or ridiculous.
<b>TO TICKLE</b>		causing laughter or amusement; humorous.
<b>TO ACT</b>		To copy what someone does or produces.
<b>BEHAVIOUR</b>		(of a person) clean, tidy, and well dressed / intelligent
<b>SILLY</b>		the use of humour, irony, exaggeration, or ridicule to expose and criticize people's stupidity or vices, particularly in the context of contemporary politics and other topical issues.
<b>TO IMITATE</b>		To take action, to do something, to behave
<b>SATIRE</b>		untrue
<b>FAKE</b>		to touch (a body part, a person, etc.) lightly so as to excite the surface nerves and cause uneasiness, laughter, or spasmodic movements
<b>AUDIENCE</b>		something (such as a knife, or gun) used to injure, defeat, or destroy
<b>INFECTIOUS</b>		(of a person) sensitive to being tickled.
<b>TO SPREAD</b>		feeling or showing hope for the future
<b>TICKLISH</b>		capable of transmitting infection
<b>OPTIMISTIC</b>		To propagate, to diffuse. / to apply on a surface
<b>WEAPON</b>		a group of listeners or spectators
