We use the present simple for future timetables and schedules

Examples:

The coach **leaves** at 8:20 am.

The museum **doesn't open** until 10 am.

What time **does** the plane **land**?

We use the present continuous for future plans and arrangements.

Examples:

We're **flying** to Auckland the following day.

She's **not coming** with us on the tour.

Are you **staying** overnight in the National Park?
