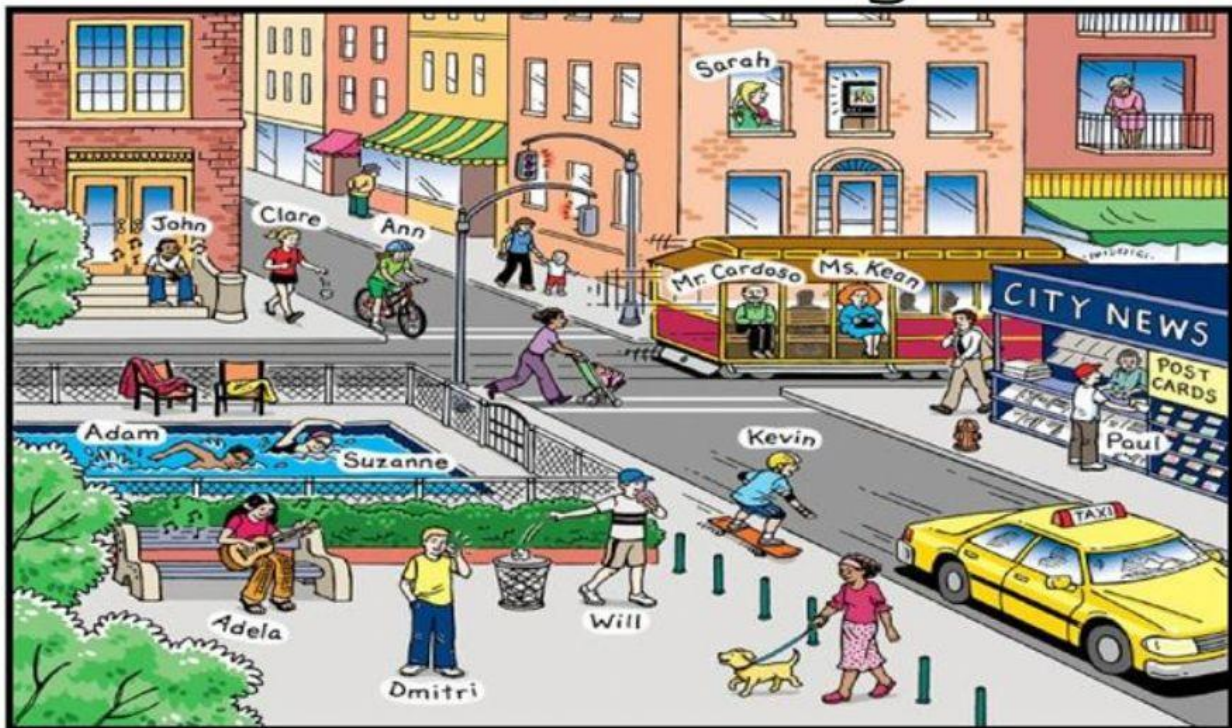


What did they do?
