Some people think origami is easy-peasy. Well, they couldn't be more wrong. Origami is not just a simple paper craft for children – it's an art, the art of paper-folding, and it takes some time to master the techniques of creating a complex piece. Its name comes from the Japanese words: "ori" which stands for folding and "kami" which means paper. In origami, you can only fold the paper in order to create a paper sculpture – so there's never any cutting or gluing.
