A list of steps to finish a task. A set of instructions that can be performed with or without a computer.

bug

A way of representing information using only two options.

a fiber optic cable

The service that translates URLs to IP addresses.

digital footprint

The most common fundamental unit of digital data

algorithm

A connection that uses light to transmit information.

pixel

The information about someone on the Internet.

binary

An instruction for the computer.

byte

Short for "picture element", the fundamental unit of a digital image

function

An error in a program that prevents the program from running as expected.
