

COMPARATIVES & SUPERLATIVES

We use them to compare animals, people and things

- Adjectives of one or two syllables: Add **-er**
Longer **Stronger** **Taller**
- One syllable adjectives ending with a vowel and a consonant, **double** the consonant:
Hotter **Bigger** **Sadder**
- Two syllables adjectives ending in **Y**, change **Y** for **I**:
Heavy - **Heavier** **Funny** - **Funnier**
- Three or more syllables adjectives, we use **more**:
Intelligent - **More intelligent**

We use them to say the biggest grade of a characteristic

- Adjectives of one or two syllables: Add **the** and **-est**
The thinnest **The Strongest** **The tallest**
- One syllable adjectives ending with a vowel and a consonant, **double** the consonant:
The hottest **The biggest** **The saddest**
- Two syllables adjectives ending in **Y**, change **Y** for **I**:
Heavy - **The heaviest** **Funny** - **The funniest**
- Three or more syllables adjectives, we use **the most**:
Intelligent - **The most intelligent**
