



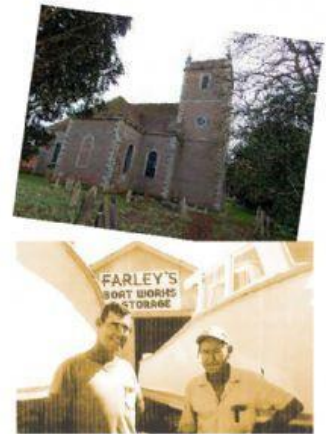
San Diego
