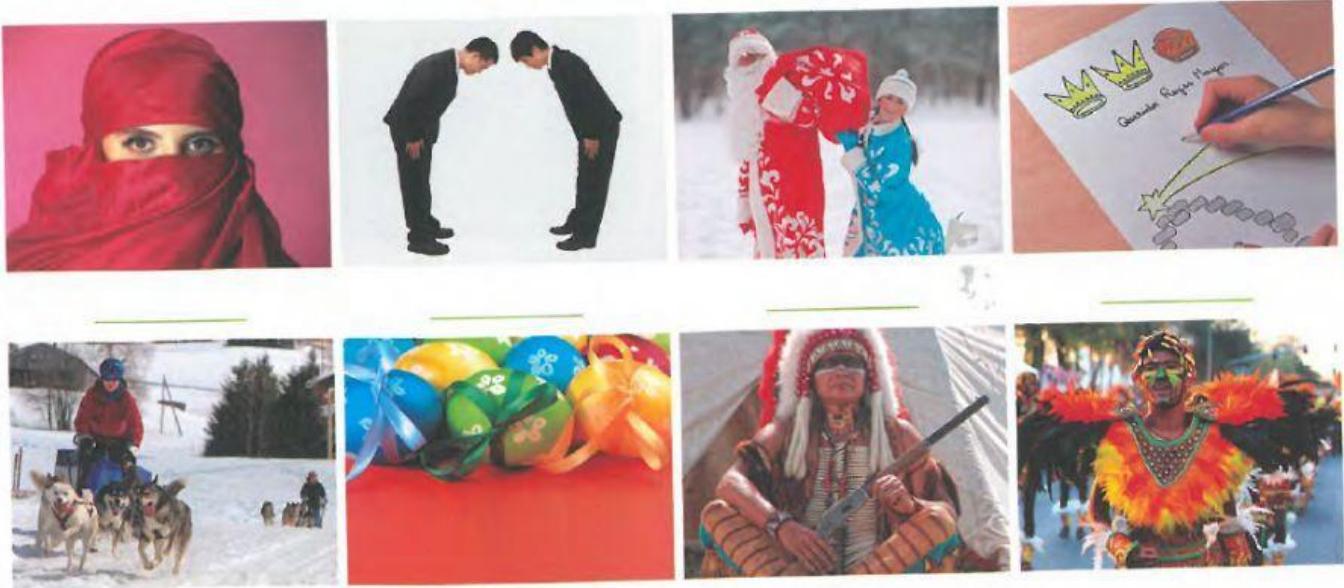


## Should I have brought flowers?
