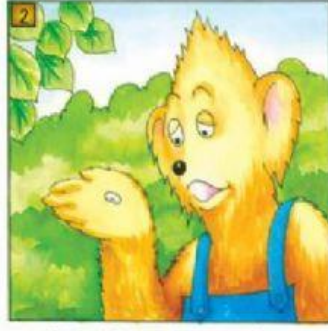

Biff's Seed.



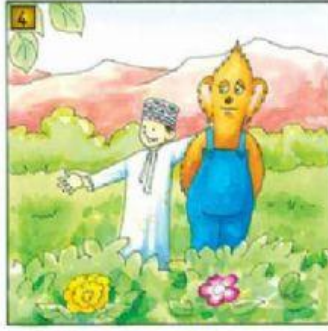
One day Biff was in the garden. He saw a lovely bird in the sky. The bird dropped something on his head. It dropped onto the ground.
