- We make the passive by using the verb be + the past participle.  
Most of the city's hotel rooms **were booked** some time ago.
- We often use the passive for describing processes.  
Some rooms **are reserved** for guests who are buying Olympic packages.
- We use by to show the person or thing that does the action.  
Many of these rooms are already booked **by** journalists and officials.
