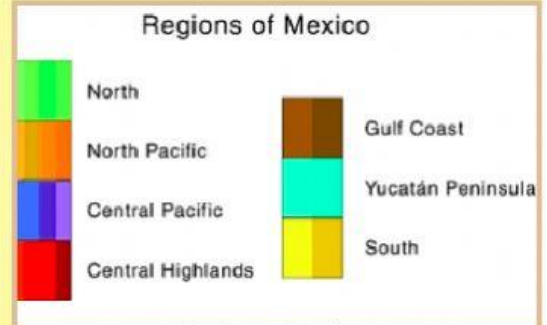


Mexican Geography
