Un-forgiveness results in bitterness and this can affect individuals both mentally and physically. It can cause stress, conflict and even severed relationships. It may be difficult to forgive a family member, but when you forgive them you begin the healing process.

The story of Joseph is an excellent example of how forgiveness can bring about reconciliation within the family. Joseph was betrayed by his brothers and sold into slavery. In the end, he was able to forgive his brothers. He realized that all he had experienced was a part of God's plan to save a generation of people. This power to forgive caused his family to be reunited and allowed his father, Jacob, to die in peace.

Problems that arise in the family should be solved in a loving manner. If family members hurt one another they should identify the problem, deal with it calmly and forgive one another.
