

**Ex. 2. Put the verbs in brackets into the *present simple*, the *present continuous*, *will* or *be going to*.**

1. A: Where <sup>1</sup> **are you going / are you going to go / will you go** for your holidays?

B: I <sup>2</sup> **am going / will go / am going to go** to Norway.

A: What <sup>3</sup> **are you doing / are you going to do / will you do** there?

B: I <sup>4</sup> **will fish / am going to fish / am fishing**.

2. *Shop assistant:* We have some very nice strawberries.

*Customer:* All right. I <sup>5</sup> **am going to have / will have / have** a pound.

3. Look at him! He <sup>6</sup> **is going to fall / will fall / is falling** off his bike.

4. *Jack:* I don't want to get married. I <sup>7</sup> **will never get / will not never get / never get** married.

*Mother:* You think that now. But one day you <sup>8</sup> **meet / are going to meet / will meet** a girl and you <sup>9</sup> **will fall / are going to fall / fall** in love.

5. A: I hear you've bought a caravan. <sup>10</sup> **Are you using / Do you use / Are you going to use** it for your holidays?

B: No, I <sup>11</sup> **am living / am going to live / live** in it.

A: What <sup>12</sup> **are you doing / are you going to do / will you do** with your house?

B: I <sup>13</sup> **am going to sell / am selling / will sell** it to the man who sold me the caravan. He <sup>14</sup> **is going to get / is getting / will get** married next month.

6. A: We <sup>15</sup> **are going to start / are starting / will start** early tomorrow. We <sup>16</sup> **are going / are going to go / will go** to Ben Nevis.

B: <sup>17</sup> **Are you going to climb / Are you climbing / Will you climb** Ben Nevis?

A: Not me. Tom <sup>18</sup> **is going to climb / is climbing / will climb** it. I <sup>19</sup> **will sit / am going to sit / am sitting** at the bottom and do some sketching.

7. A: I'm afraid I'm not quite ready.

B: Never mind. I <sup>20</sup> **am going to wait / will not wait / will wait.**
