

Merriweather Lewis and **William Clark** were famous American explorers. They wanted to explore America and to learn more about the country. In 1804, they took a crew of men and travelled across America from Missouri to the Pacific Ocean and back again. Lewis and Clark travelled for two years, four months and ten days.

They travelled through forests and desert areas. They sailed along rivers in boats and they explored mountains and caves. They discovered species of fish, birds and animals, such as the grizzly bear, and they discovered volcanoes, such as Mount Adams and Mount Hood.

Lewis and Clark gave names to the places they found. They wrote about all the things they saw and they sent the information back to President Thomas Jefferson. Jefferson wanted to know about the geography, plants and animals in America. Lewis and Clark sent him lots of maps of the country and they sent him some new species of plants.

Lewis and Clark were the first people to learn so much about America. They became American heroes and people still remember them today.
