COMPLETE THE RULES USING THE ADJECTIVES FROM THE BOX IN THE COMPARATIVE FORM

BAD LARGE HOT SHORT HAPPY DANGEROUS

- With most short adjectives, we add *-er*.
- With short adjectives ending in *-e*, we add *-r*.
- With short adjectives ending in one vowel + one consonant, we double the final letter and add *-er*.
- With adjectives ending in *-y*, we change *-y* to *-i* and add *-er*.
- With long adjectives, we use *more* before the comparative adjective.
- When we compare two things, we use *than* after the comparative adjective.
- Some adjectives have irregular comparative forms.
