VOCABULARY IN CONTEXT

TALKING ABOUT VOLUNTARY ACTIONS IN THE FUTURE AND PREDICTIONS

- ❖ We can use the Future Simple to talk about future facts and for things that are less certain:
 - **The sun will go down** at 6:30 p.m.
 - **We are visiting** my friend tomorrow.
- ❖ We often use 'will' when we're talking about an on-the-spot decision (a decision made at the moment of speaking), usually to offer help or to make a promise
 - **A: It's hot in here.**
 - **B: I'll open** the window.
- ❖ We also use Future Simple to talk about something that we want to do or don't want to do in the future
 - **I will send** my mom flowers.
 - **I won't go** to that concert.

Future Simple Tense

Positive Sentences

- My mother **will retire** next year.
- I **will call** him as soon as possible.
- We **will overcome** the problems.
- We **will live** the house.
- He **will try** to contact us next week.

Negative Sentences

- He **will not (won't) play** basketball.
- I **will not (won't) call** him as soon as possible.
- We **will not (won't) overcome** the problems.
- We **will not (won't) live** the house.
- He **will not (won't) try** to contact us next week.

Question Sentences

- **Will** your mother **retire** next year?
- **Will** he **play** basketball?
- **Will** you **meet** with him?
- **Will** you **send** him a message?
- **Will** she **overcome** the problems?

Fix the sentences:

I will ~~to~~ do that later.

She will cook dinner ~~yesterday~~.

They will hear ~~x~~ you.
