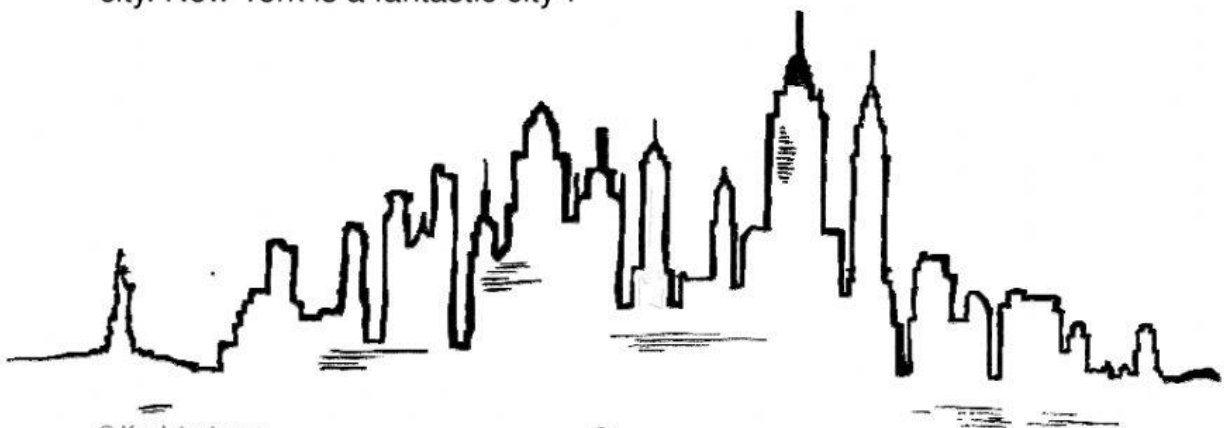
New York is a city in the United States of America. It is located on the East Coast. It is next to the Atlantic Ocean. About 8.400.000 people live there. People speak English.
