Before	Relative pronouns	after	Example
Thing - animal	← <b>Which</b> →	→	That's the car <b>which</b> I bought last year.
Person	← <b>who</b> →	→ Verb	That's the man <b>who</b> lives in the house on the hill.
<b>That:</b> we use "that" when we talk about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• things, animal</li><li>• people</li></ul>			That's the car <b>that</b> I bought last year.  That's the man <b>that</b> lives in the house on the hill.
<b>Where:</b> we use where when we talk about place.			I forgot <b>where</b> I put my key.
