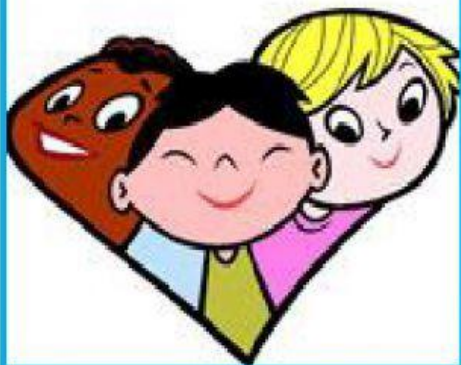


## PAST SIMPLE "HAVE"



### AFFIRMATIVE

I **had**  
You **had**  
He **had**  
She **had**  
It **had**  
We **had**  
You **had**  
They **had**

### INTERROGATIVE

**Did** I have?  
**Did** you have?  
**Did** he have?  
**Did** she have?  
**Did** it have?  
**Did** we have?  
**Did** you have?  
**Did** they have?

### NEGATIVE

I **didn't** have  
You **didn't** have  
He **didn't** have  
She **didn't** have  
It **didn't** have  
We **didn't** have  
You **didn't** have  
They **didn't** have

### SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, I <b>did</b>	No, I <b>didn't</b>
Yes, you <b>did</b>	No, you <b>didn't</b>
Yes, he <b>did</b>	No, he <b>didn't</b>
Yes, she <b>did</b>	No, she <b>didn't</b>
Yes, it <b>did</b>	No, it <b>didn't</b>
Yes, we <b>did</b>	No, we <b>didn't</b>
Yes, you <b>did</b>	No, you <b>didn't</b>
Yes, they <b>did</b>	No, they <b>didn't</b>
