

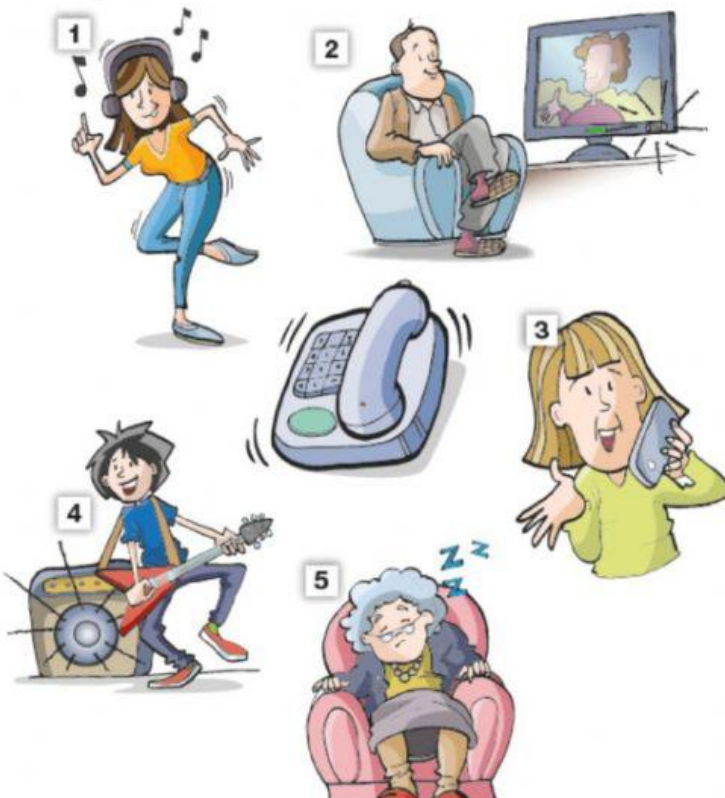

Affirmative	Negative
He <b>was wearing</b> weird clothes.	The bus <b>wasn't going</b> fast.
They <b>were standing</b> in the street.	They <b>weren't wearing</b> weird clothes.
Yes/No questions	Short answers
<b>Was he wearing</b> a hat?	Yes, he <b>was</b> . No, he <b>wasn't</b> .
<b>Were they wearing</b> weird clothes?	Yes, they <b>were</b> . No, they <b>weren't</b> .
