We use them to compare animals, people and things

- Adjectives of one or two syllables: Add -er Longer Stronger Taller
- One syllable adjectives ending with a vowel and a consonant, double the consonant: Hotter Bigger Sadder
  - Two syllables adjectives ending in Y, change Y for I: Heavy - Heavier Funny - Funnier
  - Three or more syllables adjectives, we use more:

Intelligent - More inteligent

## SUPERLATIVES

We use them to say the biggest grade of a characteristic

Adjectives of one or two syllables:
Add the and -est

The thinest The Strongest The tallest

- One syllable adjectives ending with a vowel and a consonant, double the consonant:
  The hottest The biggest The saddest
  - Two syllables adjectives ending in Y, change Y for I:

Heavy - The heaviest Funny - The funniest

 Three or more syllables adjectives, we use the most:

Intelligent - The most intelligent
