

### First conditional sentences

The conditional sentence consists of 2 parts.

If Clause



Simple Present (V1)



Uncompleted sentence

Main Clause



will + base



Meaningful sentence

Simple present: V1

V1 + s (if the subject  
is singular)

Negation:

Don't (plural)  
Doesn't (singular)

Unless = if not

e.g: **If** people **do not** understand animal behavior, they will not spot the signs of stress.

( **not** ) وجاء بعدها ( **If** ) في الجملة السابقة، استعملنا

Unless people **understand** the animal behavior, they will not spot the signs of stress.

( **not** ) : قمنا بحذف الـ ( **unless** ) وعندما استخدمنا
