Clues:

Argentina beat Yugoslavia by three goals to two in Quarter-final B.
West Germany beat Czechoslovakia one-nil in Quarter-final D.
In Quarter-final A, Italy beat Ireland by one goal to nil.
In Quarter-final C, Cameroon lost to England by two goals to three.

In the Semi-finals, the team who won Quarter-final B beat the team who won Quarter-final A by five goals to four. And, by the same score, the team who won Quarter-final D beat the team who won Quarter-final C.

The score in the final was one-nil: the winning team had beaten Czechoslovakia and England on their way to the final.

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
