Topic: Addition to Subtraction

Solve.

Examples: $3 + \underline{\quad} = 5$

$$3 + \underline{2} = 5$$

$$5 - 2 = 3$$

$$10 + \underline{\quad} = 13$$

$$10 + \underline{3} = 13$$

$$13 - 3 = 10$$
