TEXT 2 | Ant Trail Experiment

This **experiment** shows how ants follow trails.

You will need:

- Ant nest
- **Piece** of paper
- Piece of apple
- Soil

1. Put the apple on the paper next to the nest.
2. **Watch** the ants go to the apple.
3. Now **move** the apple.
4. Put some soil over the trail. The ants will run around and then make a new trail.
