Barbecue Safety

Many people (1) _____ having barbecues at home. Barbecues are fun and a great way to relax with family and friends. Barbecues are safe if you (2) _____ them properly, but unfortunately, they can sometimes be the source of serious accidents. The most common types of accidents (3) _____ barbecues are burns, scalds and other injuries related to fire, or injuries caused by sharp objects such as knives.

If you are planning to have a barbecue, there are several things you can do to (4) _____ accidents. First of all, consider carefully where you are going to put your barbecue. Avoid placing it near fences, sheds and trees, or (5) _____ other things which could catch fire. Never (6) _____ to light a barbecue in an enclosed space.



Remember to check that your barbecue is in good condition, especially if you haven't used it for a long time. Start preparing your barbecue early, to ensure it is at the right temperature by the time you are ready to (7) _____. Never pour petrol onto a barbecue, as this is extremely dangerous and can cause it to (8) _____. When you start to cook, use tools with long handles.

(9) Don't try (10) _____ the barbecue until it has cooled down. Keep an eye on the barbecue at all times. At the end of the evening, make sure the barbecue is completely extinguished.
