

1. The opportunity has arrived for us to see our family outdoors, be it six people or **two households**.
2. The PM stresses that this small step towards freedom can only be taken due to months of **sacrifice** and **effort**.
3. However, he recommends proceeding with **caution**.
4. Boris Johnson announces that the previous day the UK had recorded **the lowest** number of infections for six months, and that deaths and hospital admissions were continuing to fall.
5. Despite this, he reminds the UK citizens that there will be more **infections**, and unavoidably more hospitalizations and, regrettably, more **deaths**.
6. He warns that after vaccinating more than **30 million** adults across the UK, it is vital to protect the most **vulnerable**.
7. Evidence has proved that vaccinating the elderly and vulnerable has helped to curb **rates** of hospitalization and death.
8. In order to reinforce current immunization, the PM implores the citizens to take up their **appointment** in April.
9. He announces vaccination for all adults in the UK by the end of **July**.
10. According to him, the vaccine taskforce has reached an agreement with GlaxoSmithKline to provide the UK with between **50 and 60 million** doses of UK-made vaccine.
