LANGUAGE	FUTURE IN THE PAST
Use different forms to talk about an event that was in the future at a point in the past.	
• was/were + going to <i>I was going to watch TV.</i> ¹ (...) ² (...)	Para hablar en pasado de cosas que ibas a hacer en el futuro = EQUIVALENTE A PRESENTE CONTINUO CON INTENCIÓN DE FUTURO
• would + verb <i>They would finish their homework later.</i> ³ (...)	Para hablar en pasado de cosas que ocurrirían en el futuro.
• was/were + about to + base form <i>was /were + on the verge of + verb + -ing</i> <i>She was about to call a friend.</i> ⁴ (...) ⁵ (...)	Para hablar de cosas en pasado que estaban a punto de ocurrir = 'ESTAR A PUNTO DE'
OTRA FORMA DE DECIR 'TO BE ABOUT TO'. TAMBIÉN SE TRADUCE COMO 'ESTAR A PUNTO DE', 'ESTAR AL BORDE'
