Female Reproductive System

The female reproductive system contains a uterus, ovaries, fallopian tubes, cervix, Clitoris, labia and vagina.

The **ovaries** produce eggs and hormones called **estrogen** and **progesterone**.

The **fallopian tubes** are connected to the uterus.
The fallopian tubes pick up the eggs produced by the

The **uterus** is a thick muscle and houses the baby before birth.

The **cervix** is at the base of the uterus. Its job is to hold the baby inside the uterus until the baby's birth.


The clitoris is located in front of the urethral opening and contains sensitive nerve endings.


The labia are the skin folds around the urethral and vaginal openings

The **vagina** is the tubular opening from the uterus to outside the body through which the baby travels when it is born. The vagina is also where sperm from the penis are deposited during sexual intercourse.

At puberty, the ovaries begin to release eggs and menstruation (monthly periods) starts. The uterus builds up its lining with extra blood and tissue to provide protection for a fertilized egg to grow into a healthy baby.

If a sperm from the male does not fertilize the egg, it passes through the vagina along with the extra blood and tissue from the uterus as a menstruation period, which usually lasts from 5 to 7 days.
