As +adjective+ as

It indicates both objects/persons being compared show similarity in terms of that quality.

- *My sister is as **smart** as your brother. =They are **equally smart**.*

Not as +adjective +as

It states that there is a difference between the items being compared. It also indicates that the latter presents more of that adjective than the first item/ person mentioned.

- *Luca is not as **talented** as Marco= Marco is **more talented than Luca**.*
