
Ex 1:

Faction	an area protected by a particular unit of the police or a division used for voting <u>purposes</u>
Incumbent	the difference between the number of votes received by the person who won and the number received by the person who is second
Multiparty	Those eligible to vote
Electorate	a group within a larger group, especially one with slightly different ideas from the main group
Precinct	involving several political parties
Plurality	A person currently holding office
