Vitamins that boost student's brainpower

A secondary school says that they have improved their students' reading and writing skills by giving the children vitamins.

Children took the vitamins and had three extra lessons during the three-month experiment. The children who took the vitamins could read and write better than those who didn't. The children could also concentrate better on their homework.

The children were tested on their reading and writing skills before and after the experiment. Teachers discovered that after the experiment 58% of the children had improved their reading skills and 18% had improved their spelling and writing skills.

Teachers believe that the experiment shows how a poor diet with not many vitamins affects children's learning. The school now has lessons to teach the children how to eat healthily.
