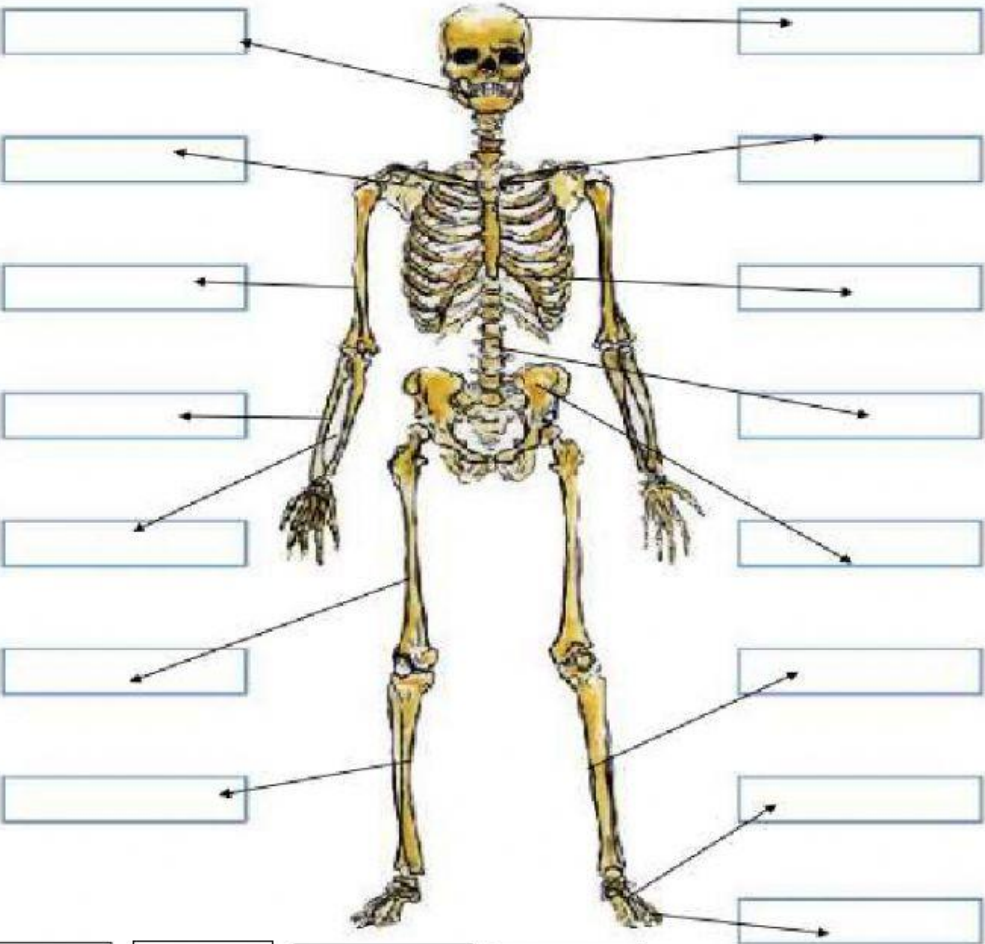


Sistema Esquelético.
